- sample seeds and worksheet below with small baggies attached

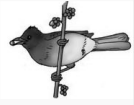
Lesson:

- read book (10 min)
- use sample seeds to discuss ways seeds travel and the properties that help them do this (10 min)
- divide into small groups - students gather seeds from garden and sort into correct bag on worksheet (10-15 min)
- regroup at picnic tables to discuss, compare and answer questions
